

Where can I exercise my dog off-leash?

Richmond is home to many designated dog off-leash areas.

Please respect other users of the off-leash areas by:

- Keeping your dog under control at all times - any dogs exhibiting aggressive behaviour must be leashed immediately.
- Picking up after your dog.
- Displaying your dog licence.
- Keeping your dog leashed when entering and exiting the off-leash area.
- Bringing no more than 3 dogs.

To provide feedback on off-leash areas contact Parks by email parks@richmond.ca or call 604-244-1208. Use of off-leash areas is regularly monitored.

How can I be a responsible dog owner?

- Keep your dog on leash at all times except in designated areas
- Clean up after your dog
- Licence your dog

What are the benefits of dog licensing?

- Your dog will be returned more quickly if it gets lost
- Provides the City useful information on dog ownership which allows us to better support animal related programs and facilities at the BCSPCA
- Saves dog owners money. Unlicensed dogs are subject to fines
