## Amendment to the Consolidated 5 Year Financial Plan (2025-2029) Bylaw No. 10622

The *Community Charter* requires that Council adopt a 5 Year Financial Plan each year prior to the adoption of the Annual Property Tax Rates Bylaw. The *Community Charter* also allows for amendments to the 5 Year Financial Plan.

Subsequent to the adoption of the City's Consolidated 5 Year Financial Plan (2025-2029) Bylaw No. 10622 on January 27, 2025, additional opportunities and projects have emerged. The current bylaw does not include these amounts. Therefore, the City is proposing to amend its Consolidated 5 Year Financial Plan Bylaw.

The proposed amendment to the Consolidated 5 Year Financial Plan (2025-2029) Bylaw No. 10622, Amendment Bylaw No. 10709 is currently available in PDF format on the City website at richmond.ca/5YFP.

The City is required by the *Community Charter* to undertake a process of public consultation before the amendment is adopted by Council, and to this end; please submit your feedback via email to <a href="mailto:finance@richmond.ca">finance@richmond.ca</a> by October 26, 2025. All feedback received will be circulated to each member of Council.

It is anticipated that Amendment Bylaw No. 10709 will be considered by Council for adoption at the Council Meeting of October 27, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. The Council meeting is open to all members of the public.
