Re: Request for Proposal 4607P – WIFI for the City of Richmond – City Hall and Public Works Yard - Addendum Two

This Addendum includes items of clarification, forms part of the Contract Documents and shall be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts. Please review and consider the following information in the preparation of your proposals:

Q1. Are CPs spaced throughout the Administration and Stores buildings so that Ethernet patch cables will easily extend to APs?

A1. The spec indicates that the Worksyard location does not have any CP's. It is a more standard Wiring closet per area with cables homerun from the closet to the device location.

Q2. Or will new cable runs be required?

A2. New cable runs will be required (as per RFP) in the Worksyard and your quote is to allow for that.

Q3. If so, how do you want them to be terminated in the wiring closets?

A3. In the closet they are to be terminated on RJ45 wall mount panels.

Q4. Is Cat5e certification appropriate?

A4. Yes
