



Gradall Operator's Forum

To meet the demand for gradalls for the City's Public Works operations, the City of Richmond (the "City") requires the services of gradalls, complete with licensed operators, on an as required basis.

The City uses gradall equipment for a variety of construction-related projects including roads shouldering (e.g. bike paths, walkways), concrete work (e.g. curb and gutter), landscaping (e.g. pathways for parks), ditch cleaning, dyke-related work (rip-rap placement) and other construction activities such as laying pipe, etc. The City's intention is to secure the availability of gradall equipment with skilled operators to fulfil these uses.

The City's total estimated annual hours of gradall usage is 2,850.

At this juncture, the City will discuss potential service solutions with gradall operators in a forum to be held at Richmond City Hall. The details are as follows:
