All adults will offer children physical and psychological safety. There will be respect for one self and the development of social responsibility towards others and our community.



MISSION STATEMENT

THE CURRICULUM

The **curriculum** in our programs is based on the children's expressed interests and developmental needs and is planned on a week-to-week and/or month-to-month basis. Each and every day there are a variety of indoor and outdoor activities available for the children to explore and investigate—including ones that address the diverse backgrounds of the children in our care, their families, and our community. Emphasis is placed on learning through play and children have the freedom and opportunity to develop five developmental selves (social, emotional, physical, intellectual and creative) by engaging in experiences that are enriching, interesting and fun.

Our childcare programs are full licensed. The school is open from September—June, except on statutory holidays, public school breaks and two professional development days.

For your child to be eligible for registration in Hamilton's Licensed School Age Care programs, your child must be in Kindergarten and no older then grade 7. Your child can still be 13 years of age and be eligible for care until the end of the school year.

Your child will be placed in the program that best suits their age as well as their social development. At points where your child are "border" ages—7 or 9 years of age, the Director of Child Care Services has the right to move the child up or down, based on what is best for the programs as a whole.
