Pride Week | July 27-August 2

Pride Week in Richmond is a celebration of members of the Two-Spirit, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex, asexual and gender diverse (2SLGBTQIA+) communities in our city. Celebrate with inclusive events and interactive activities with local leaders, artists, performers and community members. The City of Richmond presents events in partnership with Community Associations and Societies, as well as the Richmond Public Library.

This year's theme, 'Pride in Momentum', reflects Pride Week as an active, evolving movement toward a more equitable and vibrant future for everyone in Richmond.

A Virtual Waiting Room Coming to Registration Nights

A virtual waiting room (queue) will be used during high-volume registration periods to manage system traffic and support a smoother experience. On busy registration dates, clients will be placed in a brief queue before entering the system to help prevent slow downs and errors and can see real-time places in line.

Note that not all registrations will have a virtual waiting room; low-traffic times will not trigger one.

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Extended Hours this Summer at the West Richmond Pitch & Putt!

Tucked inside beautiful Hugh Boyd Community Park, Richmond's nine hole golf course is a hidden gem waiting to be explored.
