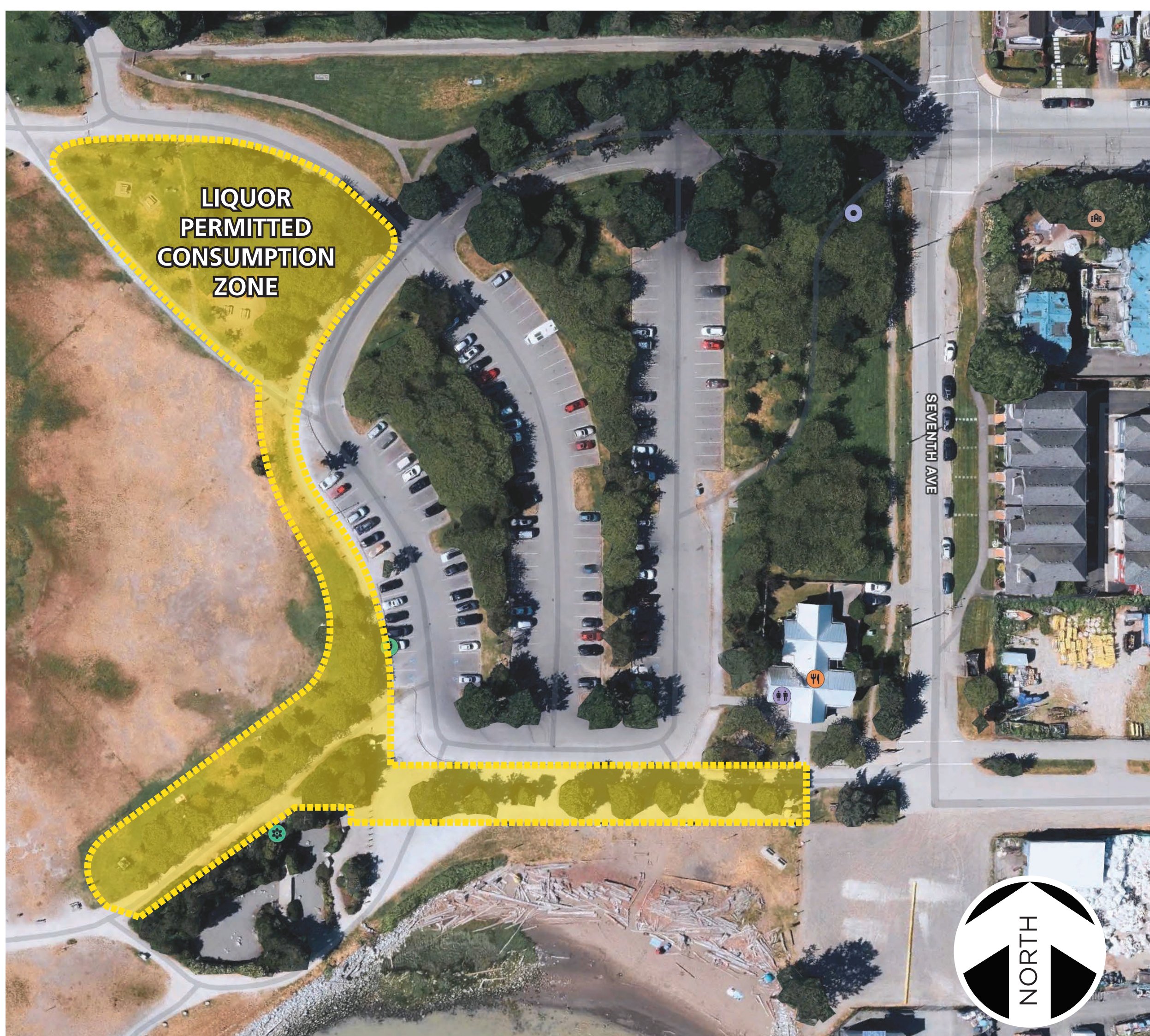


Garry Point Park

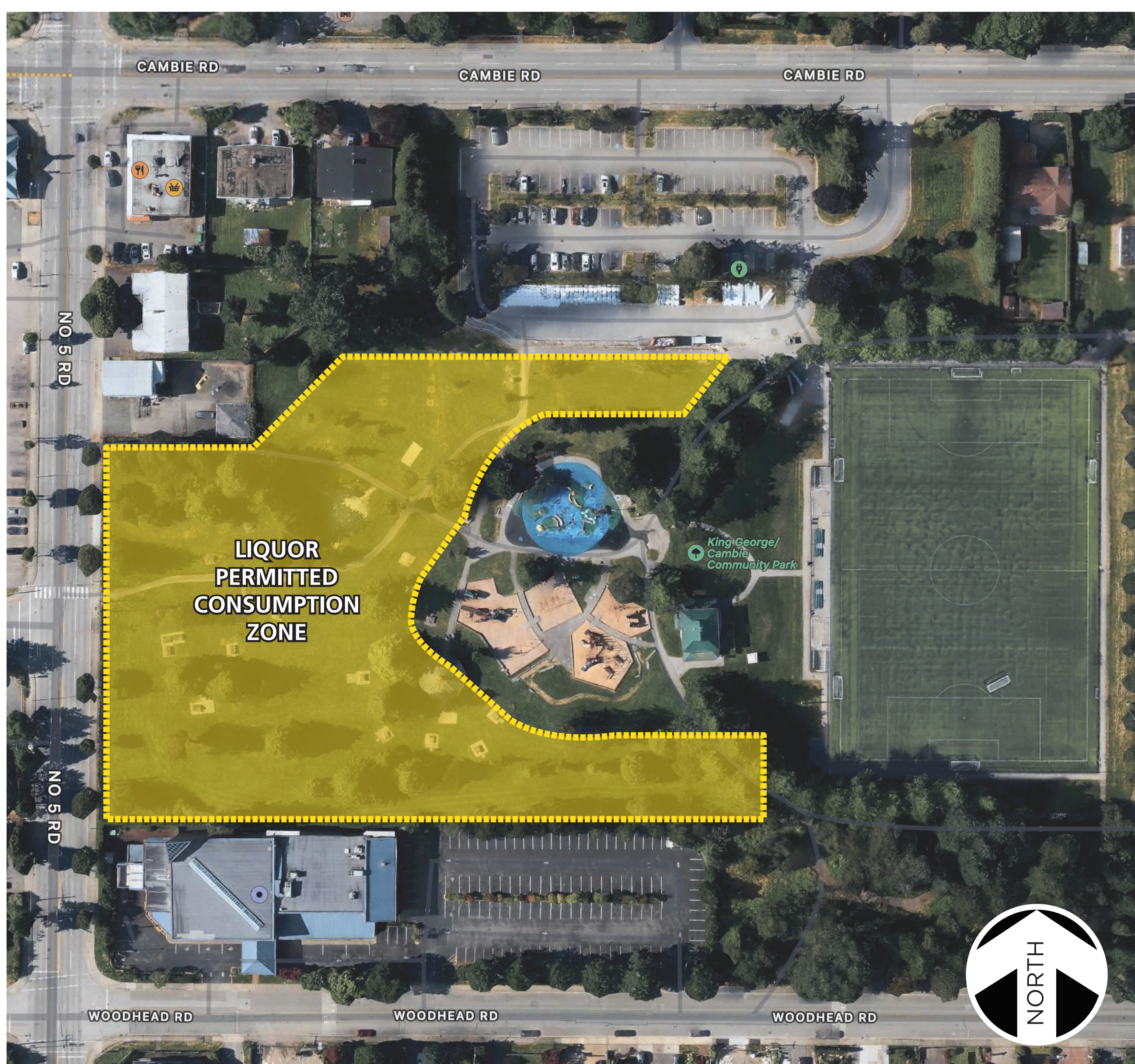


King George / Cambie Community Park

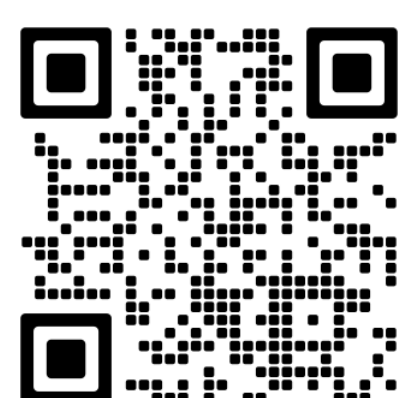
