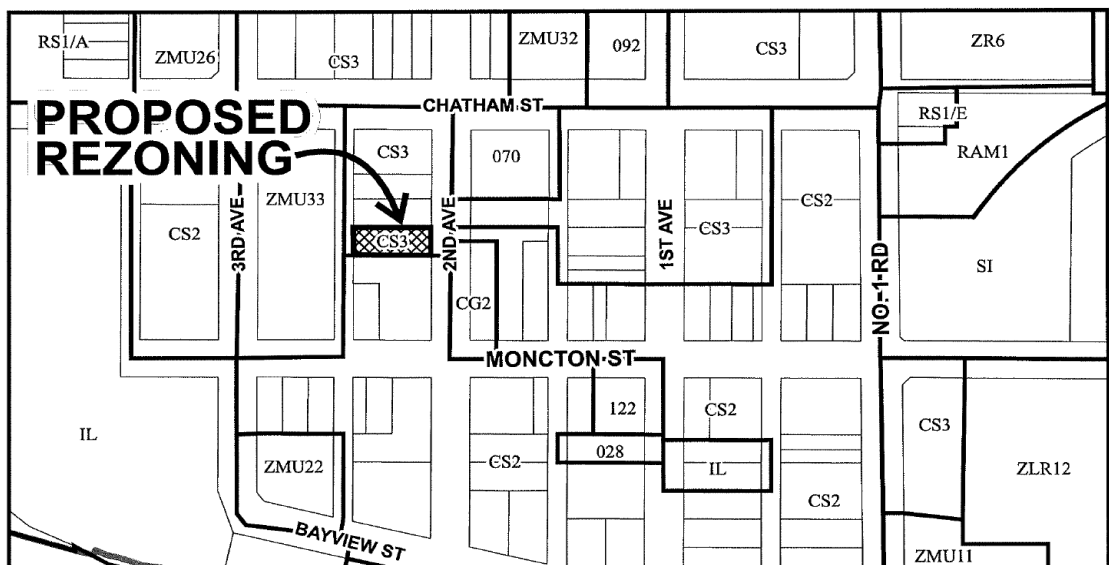
1. RICHMOND ZONING BYLAW 8500, AMENDMENT BYLAW 10571 (RZ 20-919115)

Location/s: 12071 2nd Avenue

Applicant/s: 1096255 B.C. LTD.

Purpose: To create a new “Commercial Mixed Use (ZMU58) – 2nd Avenue (Steveston Village)” zone and to rezone the subject property from “Steveston Commercial (CS3)” zone to the “Commercial Mixed Use (ZMU58) – 2nd Avenue (Steveston Village)” zone to allow development of a three-storey, mixed-use building containing commercial space at grade and six residential units above, with vehicular access from the lane (west).

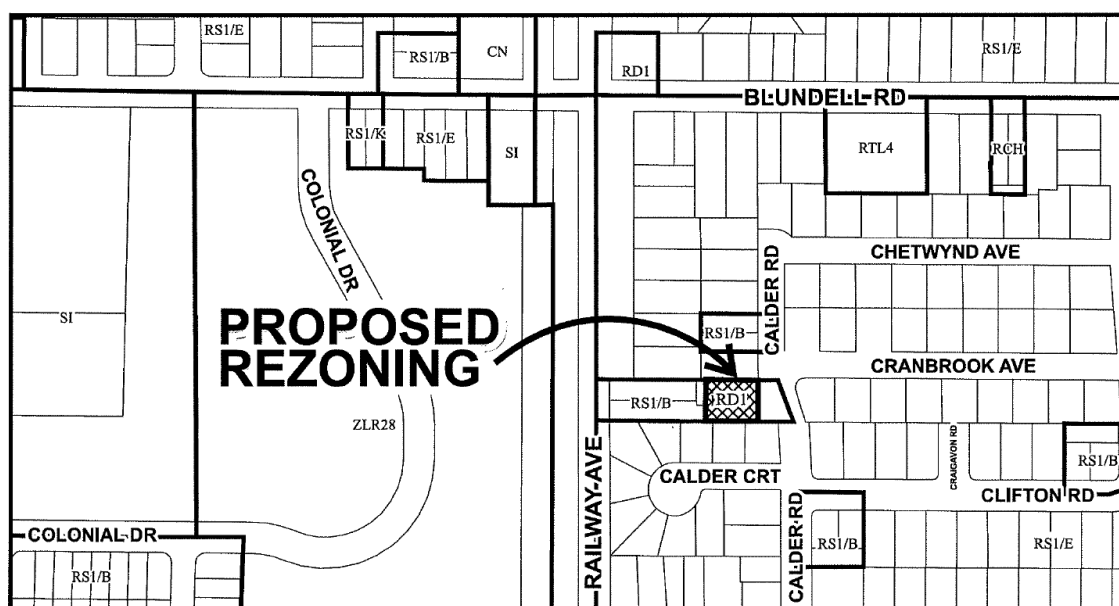
2. RICHMOND ZONING BYLAW 8500, AMENDMENT BYLAW 10581 (RZ 23-024173)

Location/s: 8171/8175 Calder Road

Applicant/s: 1142327 B.C. Ltd. (Directors: Anwer Kamal and Nayyer Kamal Jilani)

Purpose: To rezone the subject property from the “Two-Unit Dwellings (RD1)” zone to the “Small-Scale Multi-Unit Housing (RSM/M)” zone, to permit subdivision into two lots.
