## 1. Richmond Zoning Bylaw 8500, Amendment Bylaw 10561

Location/s:	City-wide
Applicant/s:	City of Richmond, as mandated by the Province of British Columbia
Purpose:	To exempt residential use in Transit-Oriented Areas from the requirement to provide a minimum amount of off-street vehicle parking spaces, other than accessible parking spaces, in compliance with the requirements of Bill 47 (Housing Statutes (Transit-Oriented Areas) Amendment Act, 2023).
