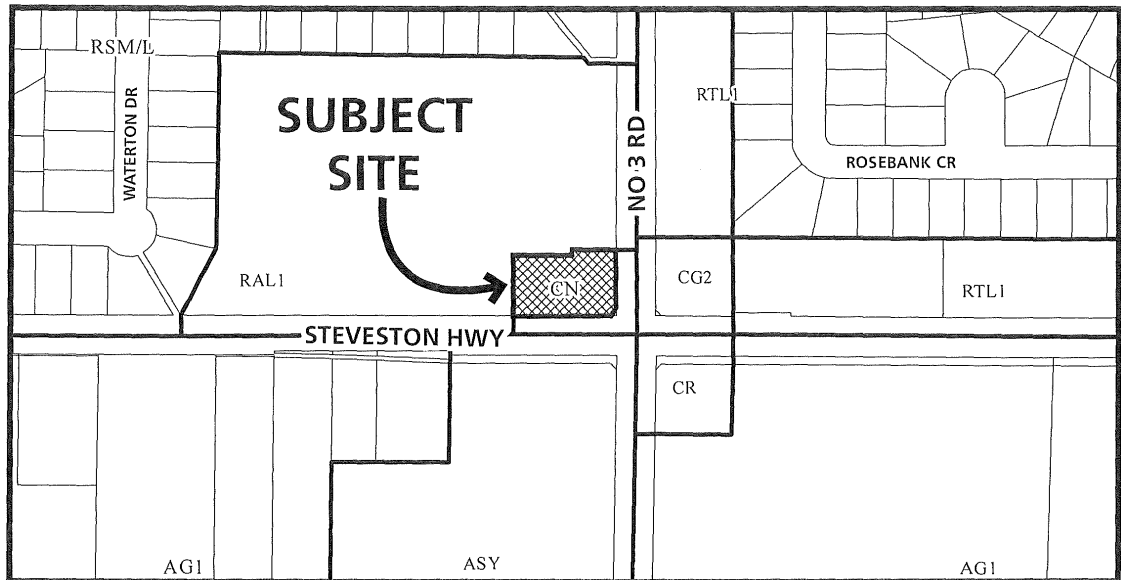

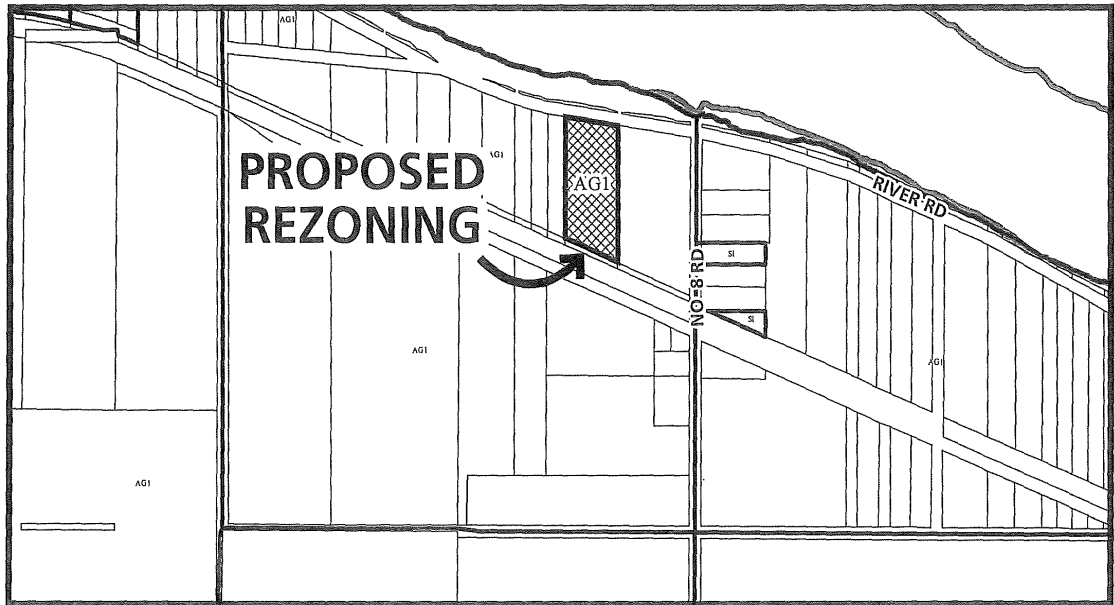
2. RICHMOND ZONING BYLAW 8500, AMENDMENT BYLAW 10733 (RZ 25-015421)

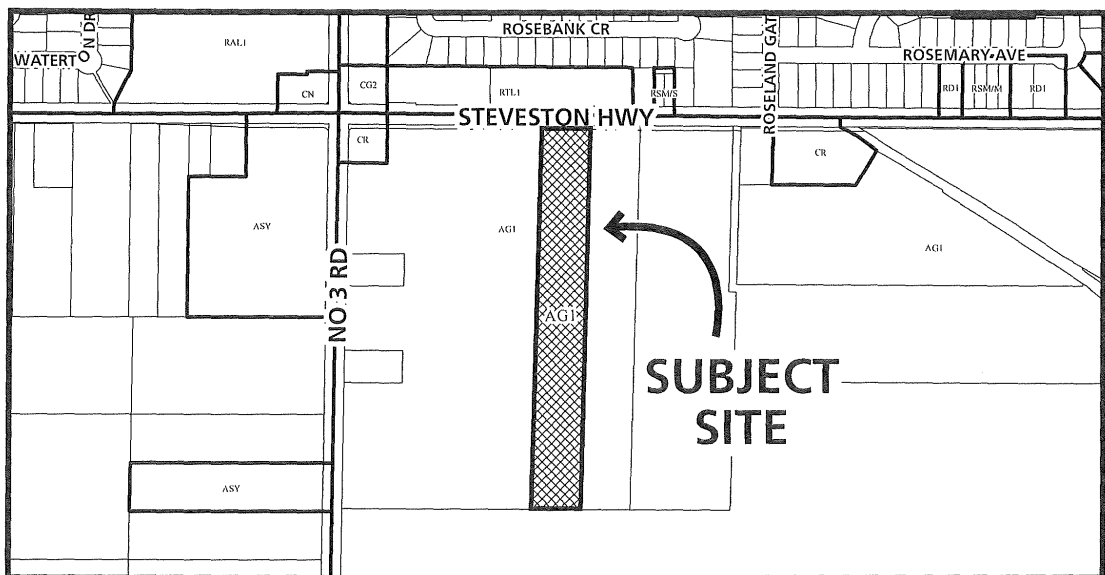
3. RICHMOND ZONING BYLAW 8500, AMENDMENT BYLAW 10747 (ZT 26-004041)
