Block Bookings: Payment is due in full upon contract confirmation. Payment can be made using cash, cheque, debit or a credit card.

CANCELLATIONS BY THE RENTER:	No refund will be issued if less than seven calendar days notice is given. If more than seven calendar days notice is given, a refund will be returned to the renter upon receipt of written notice of the cancellation.		
CANCELLATIONS BY THE CITY:	The City reserves the right to cancel, postpone or reschedule a rental slot.		
FIELD CLOSURES:	There are times when it becomes necessary to close fields during extreme weather conditions and maintenance. The field closure information is updated weekdays before 2:00pm.
