The Richmond Speed Skating Oval project is located at 6080 River Road in Richmond, British Columbia, Canada. It will be a multi-purpose facility that will host the long track speed skating competition at the 2010 Winter Olympics. This legacy facility will have a total floor area of 46,000 m². There will be two mass strip footings supported by 500 piles. The first floor is an at-grade reinforced concrete raft slab, including 14,000 m² of parking. The second floor is a post-tensioned, precast/cast-in-place suspended slab, which will include a 12,000 m² Superflat ice slab. The roof is metal deck supported by glu-lam/structural steel composite arches and purlins. The arches span 96m and are supported by reinforced concrete piers at either end.

Interested Companies are to submit two (2) completed Contractor's Qualification Statements CCDC 11-1996 to the Purchasing and Insurance Department, Information Counter, Main Floor, Richmond City Hall, 6911 No 3 Road, Richmond, BC, V6Y 2C1, Canada. Separate prequalifications in separate envelopes shall be submitted when expressing interest in multiple trade packages. Submissions should indicate the trade package of interest in the title (e.g. 2801PQ Elevators". Submissions will be received until 2:00 p.m., local time, Friday, February 10, 2006.

Submittals will be reviewed and evaluated with the objective of developing a short list of pre-qualified firms. The trade tender packages are expected to be issued between March and August of 2006.
