Re: Contract T.5086 – 2014 Asphaltic Concrete Paving - Addendum Four

This addendum forms part of the Contract Documents and shall be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts. The costs of all work contained herein shall be included in the Contract Price. The following revisions supersede the information contained in the original Contract Document to the extent referenced and shall become part thereof.

I. Responses to the tenderer's questions:

Question No.1 Milling depths available? And if not will you provide us with an average depth?

City's response Milling depths may vary between 0mm to 120mm. If the depth exceeds the noted range then the Contract Administrator will seek the reflective cost changes under MMCD prescribed CCO and CO process.

Question No.2 Under the "Measurement of and payment for work" Item 6 – Machine Laid Asphalt, Less than 1000m² states that it will be paid for by the m², however the Schedule of Quantities and Prices in the tender form shows the unit as TNN, therefore please clarify if item 6 of the tender for should read 1000 m² as opposed to 1000 tnn and if so will a revised Schedule of Quantities be issued?

City's response Machine Laid Asphalt for surface area(s) less than 1000m² will be paid for by the tonnes (TNN) of placed mix. 1000m² notation signifies the work area for which the unit rate of laid asphalt is sought under the current advertised tender herein referenced to T.5086. 1000TNN represents the estimated quantity. The numeric similarity for the two distinct entities is purely coincidental.
No revision to the advertised "Schedule of Quantities and Prices" is warranted at this time.

Question No.3 Under the “Measurement of and payment for work” Item 7 – Machine Laid Asphalt, Less than 5000m² states that it will be paid for by the m², however the Schedule of Quantities and Prices in the tender form shows the unit as TNN, therefore please clarify if item 7 of the tender for should read 5000 m² as opposed to 4000 tnn and if so will a revised Schedule of Quantities be issued?

City’s response Machine Laid Asphalt for surface area(s) less than 5000m² will be paid for by the tonnes (TNN) of placed mix. 5000m² notation signifies the work area for which the unit rate of laid asphalt is sought under the current advertised tender herein referenced to T.5086. 4000TNN represents the estimated quantity of laid mix anticipated for placement scenario’s involving area(s) that is less than 5000m². No revision to the advertised “Schedule of Quantities and Prices” is warranted at this time.

Question No. 4 In regards to item 19 of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices what type of curb will we be installing?

City’s response Please refer to MMCD Platinum Edition, Volume II and Standard Detail Drawings C2, C3, C4, C5, C6.
