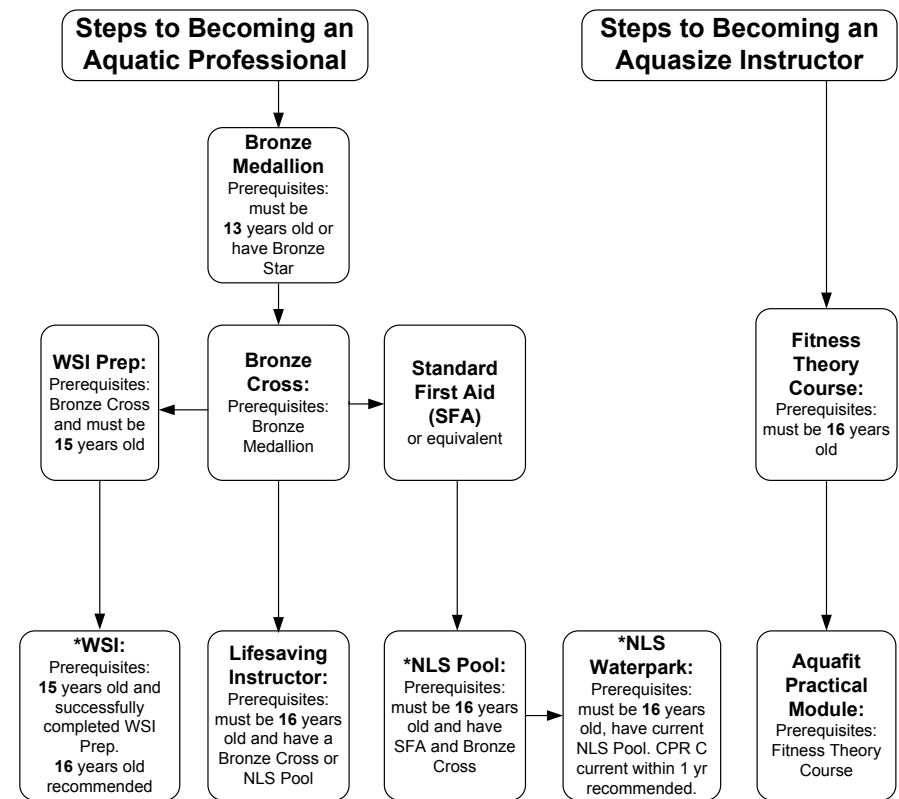

* Required for employment with Richmond. A CPR 'C' certificate (current within one year) is also required.

High school credits

Students may use their Bronze Cross, Water Safety Instructor, Lifesaving Instructor, and NLS certifications for credits toward high school graduation.

Credits

- Bronze Cross is worth two credits for Grade 11.
- Lifesaving Instructor + Bronze Cross is worth three credits for Grade 11.
- NLS is worth two credits for Grade 12.

Process

Students are asked to inform their school counsellor in charge of curriculum that they wish to use these certifications as part of the "External Credit Program."

Students will be asked to provide proof of their certification card(s).
