BADMINTON INSTRUCTOR

Applications are being accepted for the position of **Badminton Instructor** at the South Arm Community Centre. Reporting to the Community Facilities Coordinator, the Badminton Instructor is responsible for the leadership and planning of badminton programs within a community services setting.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Plan, implement and evaluate developmentally appropriate sport activities with supporting weekly lesson plans that are creative, flexible, and adaptable.
- Supervise, instruct and build relationships with children.
- Provide a safe, positive and well-managed learning environment.
- Teach developmentally appropriate sport specific skills.
- Instruct physical literacy skills based on age and skill level of participants.
- Responsible for leadership and support of the Sports Instructor 1 and volunteers.
- Greet parents at the beginning and end of each class and discuss program information.
- Communicate with other staff and volunteers.
- Be a positive role model for participants.
- Follow Community Centre and off-site protocol for emergency situations.
- Ensure the safety of all individuals participating.
- Ensure the physical and emotional environment is safe for children.
- Report and document suspected child abuse, endangerment and neglect to supervisor.
- Ensure attendance procedures are followed.
- Clean and maintain room and equipment; assess equipment on a regular basis and report damaged items to supervisor.
- Ensure appropriate set up, take down and maintenance of program room and space.
- Fill out accident and/or incident report forms.
- Provide evaluation and feedback to supervisor regarding program content.
- Other related duties as assigned and may vary according to facility.
