Property tax deadline approaching

Richmond property owners are reminded that property taxes are **due Thu, July 2**.

Property tax notices have been mailed. Those who have not received their notice should do one of the following:

- Contact the City Tax Department immediately at 604-276-4145
- Visit City Hall in person with photo identification to request a copy
- Access their account online at richmond.ca/MyRichmond

Property taxes must be paid, the home owner grant claimed and property tax deferment applications or renewals completed by the due date to avoid penalty.
