Help keep Richmond moving clean and green

We are proposing a major expansion to our public electric vehicle charging network and we would like to hear from you. In phase one of the expansion, we are considering installing 24 to 30 new Level 3 Direct Current Fast Chargers, creating charging hubs at three Cityowned facilities:

- Richmond Curling Centre
- Minoru Park Precinct (Cultural Centre Annex)
- South Arm Community Centre

These fast chargers would provide high-speed, reliable charging in high-demand areas in the City Centre, where many residents live in multi-unit residential buildings and lack access to private home charging. You can provide feedback online or at one of the pop-up information hubs.
