

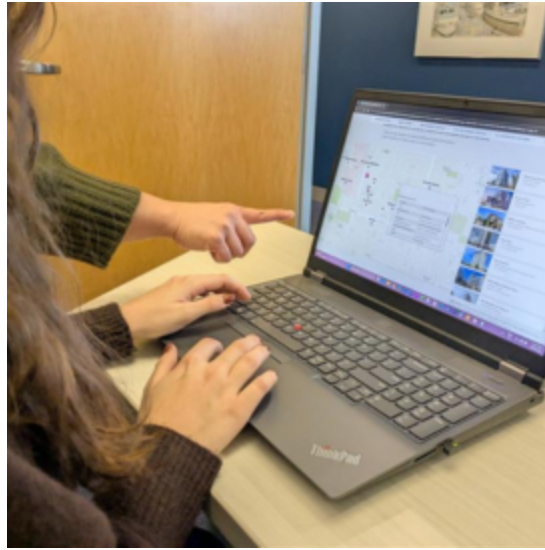

The 2026 Lulu Awards for Urban Design recognizes, celebrates, and inspires excellence in urban design, including residential development across Richmond.

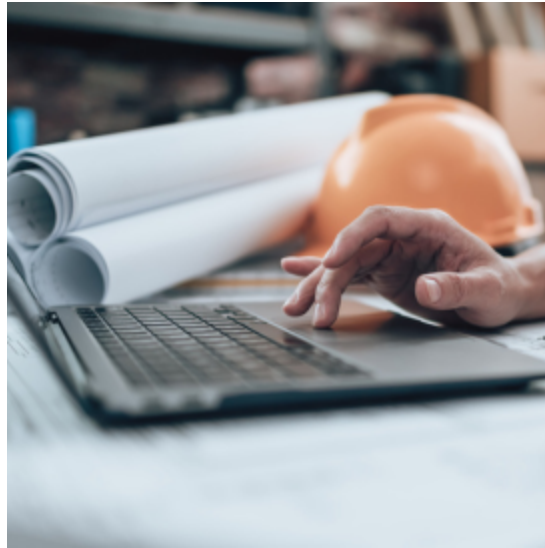
Submissions are now open until Tuesday, March 31, 2026, with award recipients to be announced in the fall.

Aberdeen Rental Residences update

The City has recently partnered with a Non-Profit Operator (NPO) known as The New Vista Society to deliver approximately 220 units of affordable rental housing on several City-owned properties on Sexsmith Road. The City and New Vista are currently exploring funding opportunities from senior levels of government.
