

NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONTRACT

The City of Richmond intends to enter into a contract for the cleaning and maintenance of large diameter / volume drainage discharge structures (Large diameter pipes, box and “U” shaped culverts).

IMPORTANT

It is the intention of the City to use a cleaning system capable of flushing and pumping out suspended debris into a filter and have the particle free water re-introduced into the sewer.

It is the intention of the City **not** to use regular vactor-trucks to clean the box culverts and pipes that will dispose both water and debris from the systems.

Estimated lineal meters and diameters of structures are as follows:

- Approximately 4 lineal kilometres of box culvert – various locations in Richmond
- Approximately 1 lineal kilometre of large diameter pipe – various locations in Richmond
