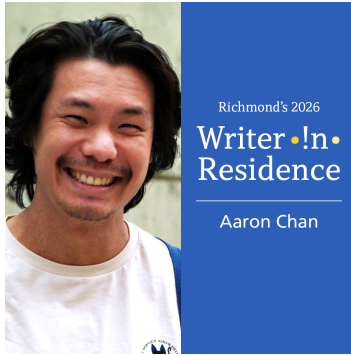


## West Richmond Pitch & Putt | Now Open!
