

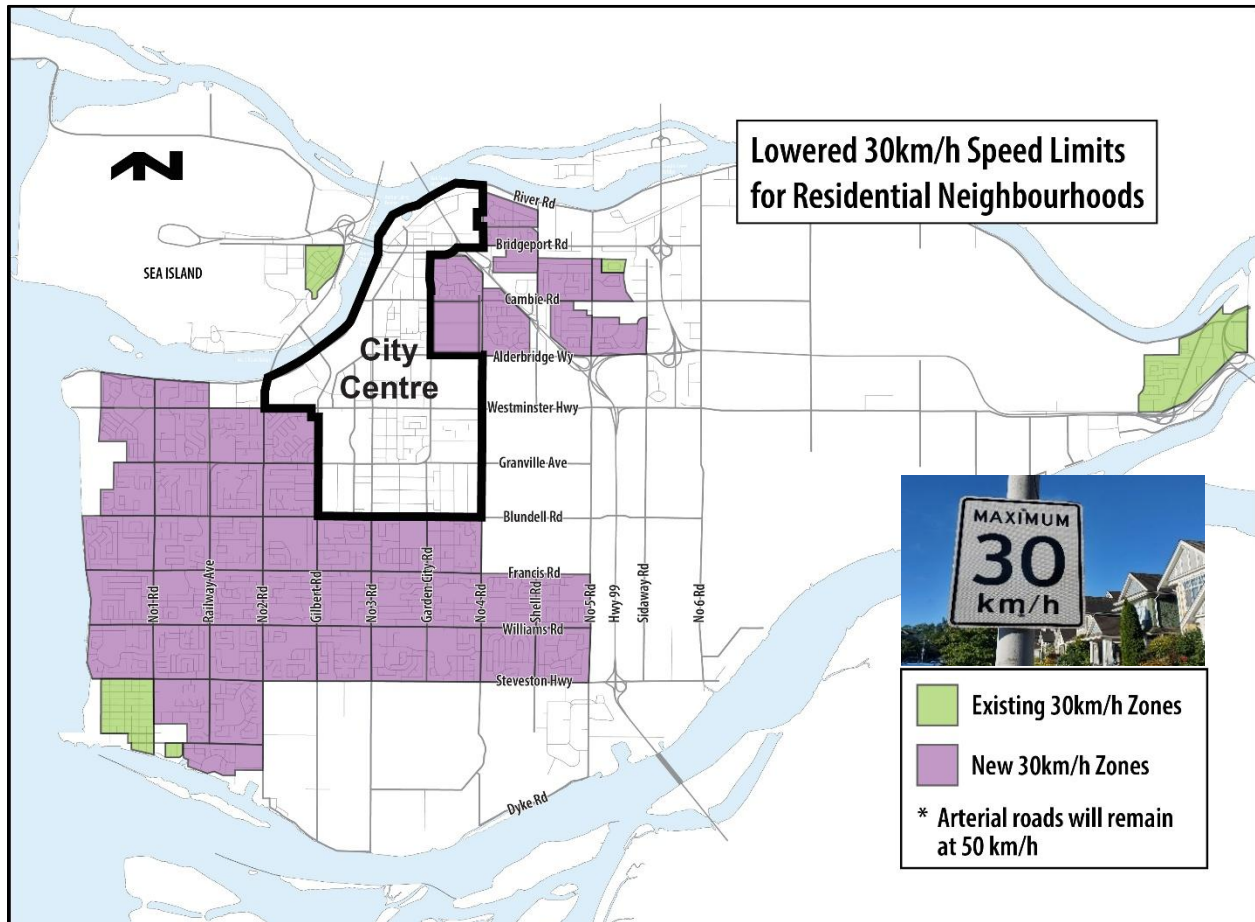


## Traffic advisory: Lowering residential neighbourhood speed limits to 30km/h

Effective June 8, 2026

To improve road safety and foster more active and liveable neighbourhoods, the City is lowering the speed limit to 30 km/h on all local residential streets in the City.

Local streets are typically in residential areas and do not have a centre line. Areas subject to the new 30 km/h speed limit are shaded purple in the map below.



Starting the week of June 22, 2026, the City is installing new 30 km/h speed limit signs at the entrances to these neighbourhoods and in school zones on local streets.
