



Traffic Advisory: BC Hydro project works at the Westminster Highway and No. 2 Road intersection

Effective September 11, 2026

While BC Hydro's work near Westminster Highway and No. 2 Road remains ongoing, BC Hydro crews will conduct additional 24-hour construction at the intersection from **September 11 through September 13, 2026** to complete heavy civil excavation.

The Traffic Management Plan will be implemented beginning at **7:00pm on Friday, September 11 and will remain in effect until 7:00pm on Sunday, September 13.**

Lane closure details:

- Between **September 11, 7:00pm** and **September 13, 7:00pm**:
 - Crews shall be authorized to work at all times (24-hours);
 - A minimum of a single lane in each direction through the intersection of No. 2 Road and Westminster Highway will be maintained at all times during this period; and
 - Left turn movements will not be permitted in the eastbound, westbound and northbound directions during this period.

During the specified hours, the suggested detour route to access Sea Island for airport operations, employees and the travelling public is the Dinsmore Bridge via Gilbert Road. Following this work, a minimum of two (2) lanes (1 through lane and 1 left turn lane) will be maintained in each direction through the No. 2 Road and Westminster Highway intersection to facilitate BC Hydro's remaining work.

Traffic control personnel will be on site to support the safe movement of vehicles and pedestrians. The public is advised that traffic delays may occur in the area during this time, and commuters are encouraged to plan accordingly.
