



Traffic Advisory: YVR Dinsmore Bridge Overnight Closures

Effective September 14, 2026

The Vancouver International Airport Authority (YVR) has advised that it will be closing the Dinsmore Bridge overnight to conduct construction nightworks that will ensure longevity, resilience, and reliability of the bridge. YVR's overnight closures will begin on **September 14 through December 31, 2026. During this period, the Dinsmore Bridge will be closed to all traffic nightly from Sunday to Friday between the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.**

Lane Closure Details:

- Dinsmore Bridge – Full bridge closure (overnight Sunday to Friday, 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.)

During the specified closure hours, the Dinsmore Bridge will be closed to all traffic and the suggested detour route to access to Sea Island for airport operations, employees, and the travelling public is the No. 2 Road Bridge via Westminster Highway. Outside of these hours, the Dinsmore Bridge will remain open to the public with a reduced speed limit of 30 km/h in place.

During the specified closure hours, traffic control personnel will be on site to support the safe movement of vehicles and pedestrians. The public is advised that traffic delays may occur in the area during this time, and commuters are encouraged to plan accordingly.
